British Columbia secondary school students placed fourth in a recent world-wide survey of science ability. However, the number of students entering and graduating from post-secondary science and technology programs in BC is declining.

British Columbia Innovation Council (BCIC) is offering support for innovative students who pursue science and technology education in our province and build careers in BC's advanced technology industries. The scholarship includes \$2,000+ for Grade 12 students and up to \$750 support for secondary schools that participate in the program.

BCIC Young Innovator Scholarships will be awarded by each school to their leading innovative students. The students will be selected through:

- "innovator profiles" administered by teacher committees, and;
- "idea mashUp" entries, a new BCIC competition encouraging technology innovation.
